## **Photo Blocker Spray and Photo Shield Reflective Licence Plate Covers**

**Do They Work?**

**Are they Illegal?**



**Well before we discuss whether or not these products actually work, let's look at their legal status.**

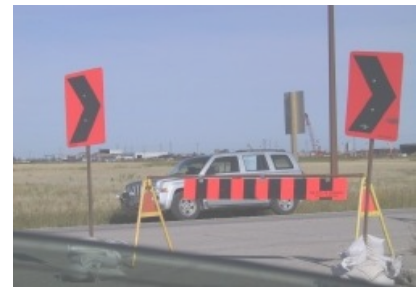
**In many jurisdictions these products are considered like Radar Detectors, where it's legal to purchase them but illegal to use them on your vehicle.**

**Before you allow the illegal status of these products to deter you from purchasing and using them though, consider this.**

**In many jurisdictions the Governments have ammended their Highway Traffic Act laws to allow just simply for sake of ease, certain Hazardous Offences like the Running of A Red Light or Speeding, to be enforced by way of Red Light Cameras and Mobile Photo Radar.**



**When you couple that with the fact that they have also ammended laws like the obscuring of your licence plate, which in most jurisdictions never had demerits attached to it, to now have Demerits Attached To It and they add in the description of products that prevent Photo Enforcement from taking a picture of your licence plate. One has to wonder, is the whole Photo Enforcement Program about Revenue or about Safety!**



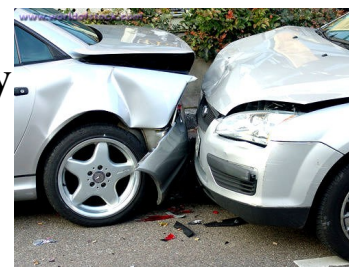
**Especially when Cities are now looking at and testing photo cameras in bus lanes, the diamond lanes. What are they protecting there, the safety of the Transit Schedule?**

**If the Government is going to say to you, that we're not going to take serious offences like speeding or the running of a red light , seriously, we're going to just allow a device to take a picture of the vehicle 'allegedly' speeding or 'allegedly' going through the red light and then send a ticket to the Registered Owner a couple of weeks later and not hold the Driver Accountable, it only confirms in Peoples' Minds that it is strictly about Revenue Generation.**



As such you may want to purchase one of these devices, to protect yourself because more and more studies are showing that the way the 'System' is set up it forces people at an intersection into what's called '**A DILEMMA ZONE**'.

Because of shortened Amber times or Minimum Amber Times a driver in many instances is forced either to slightly accelerate, going just above a very low threshold, which in many jurisdictions is **10 kilometres over the Speed Limit**, or it causes them to enter the intersection within the first second of the signal change. Which statistically does not cause accidents and is not hazardous. The only other option is to jam on the brakes and possibly be involved in a rear end collision.



The same goes for mobile photo radar, studies show that extreme high speeds make up only less than 1% of tickets issued. Most are issued slightly above a very low speed threshold that's put onto the camera.

Now with the Photo Blocker Spray, does it work? There's nothing that I've been able to find to indicate it doesn't effectively work. However the downfall with this and the reflective plate cover is of course, you have to make sure that you keep them clean!



**The spray is invisible to the Human Eye, however when subjected to a high density flash, the chemical that is sprayed on produces a reflection back towards the Camera obscuring the plate.**



**There's no Officer Safety issues involved because it's not effected by an average consumer camera, it's not effected by head lights, take down lights or high beam lights from a vehicle. The Officer is at any time able to see the plate completely so there's no Officer Safety Issues. The only issue to Law Enforcement is the fact that it obscures the plate from a photo enforcement location.**

**Now with the plate cover, of course it is visible to the human eye and it's more likley that an Officer will see it and perhaps pull you over, seize it and ticket you for it. However this offence can be defended in court as well and we can show you how to do that.**



**With the spray, because it's not visible to the human eye, an Officer just can't guess at whether or not you've applied it to your plate. They can't act strictly on suspicion, they have to have Reasonable and Probable Grounds to Believe that you have applied a substance to your licence plate. The only way they are going to find that out is if you admit it to them and tell them that you did.**

**As well, Keep in mind that the average Police Officer isn't going to be wondering the streets day and night looking for people who have applied spray to their licence plate or using plate covers.**

**Many Police Officers themselves have been effected by the Photo Enforcement campaigns and many of them, do not like the program as well, because they know that it's about revenue and not about safety. So as I said, they have a lot of more important things to do then run around looking for people who may have applied spray to their licence plate.**
